Foundation Funds

The Foundation is committed to helping Summit Pacific Medical Center achieve its vision of building the healthiest community in the Nation. This is no small feat for our organization, but we like to aim for the stars.

New Equipment & Construction

All monies donated to this fund go to Summit Pacific Medical Center (Grays Harbor Public Hospital District No. 1) to purchase new equipment and fund necessary construction and remodeling projects.

Student Scholarship Fund

Summit employees and community members contribute annually to a scholarship fund to promote the education and integration of local high school and college students entering healthcare fields.

Greatest Need General Fund

Donors to the Greatest Need General Fund create hope, health and healing for our community and all those served by Summit Pacific Medical Center. The Greatest Need Fund is unrestricted, which enables the Summit Pacific Medical Foundation Board of Directors (in coordination with hospital leadership) to act quickly on immediate needs. This fund offers a flexible source of support. Your gift goes directly where help is needed the most.

Patient Assistance Fund

Our Patient Assistance Fund provides patients with the medications and travel expenses they need, but are not always able to afford. Additionally, the Comfort for Kids program provides stuffed animals and stickers to our youngest patients to help calm them and make the hospital a less scary place.

Employee Assistance Fund

The Foundation's newest fund aims to provide one-time grants to Summit employees facing exceptional personal hardship. While FMLA assists with necessary family leaves of absence, this fund specifically provides relief for staff .5 FTE or greater in good standing who have experienced a medical emergency, an accident or loss of home due to natural causes requiring the employee to take time away from work.




