### **Summit Pacific's Urgent Care Clinic to Open Mondays Starting Memorial Day Weekend**

Elma, Washington – For those needing medical care over Memorial Day weekend, Summit Pacific Medical Center's Urgent Care Clinic will be open, Friday, May 22 through Monday, May 25 from noon to 8 p.m. Grays Harbor's only urgent care clinic is located within Summit Pacific Medical Center at 600 East Main Street in Elma. Summit Pacific is expanding their urgent care service by opening on Mondays, starting Memorial Day, from noon to 8 p.m. The clinic will now offer urgent care services every Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Mondays, noon to 8 p.m.

Summit Pacific's Urgent Care Clinic began operating in February of 2015. Summit Pacific plans to increase days and hours of service as the need presents, starting with the addition of Mondays. The urgent care clinic provides walk-in appointments for patients suffering pains and discomfort associated with colds, flu, sinus infections, ear aches and stomach ailments; minor sprains, wounds, burns and rashes; minor gynecological and pregnancy concerns (less than 20 weeks); and male urogenital concerns. Urgent care is not meant to take the place of an emergency department for those suffering a life or limb threatening situation; or that of routine visits with a primary care provider. If more emergent care is needed, staff will be able to escort patients immediately down the hall to Summit Pacific's 24/7 Emergency Department.

Patients coming to Summit Pacific Medical Center's Urgent Care, should check-in at the main patient entrance found off Main Street in Elma, and avoid using the Emergency Department Entrance.
